All Ireland Championships	Open to full driving members of Horse Sport Ireland, Northern Ireland Carriage Driving Association or British Carriagedriving. All drivers must have completed a 3-phase combined event in 2017/2018. €80 for senior drivers, all classes. €40 for drivers under 18 years.
BC Qualifier	Open to full driving members of British Carriagedriving BC start fee rates for 2018 apply. Payment to be paid with entry on separate cheque, payable to <i>British Carriagedriving</i> <u>Note –</u> <i>A completed BC Entry Form and declaration must be provided on arrival</i> <u>For Novice qualifiers</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>BC and NICDA drivers will require a completed BC Competency Form</i>• <i>HSI drivers will require a competency letter from Horse Sport Ireland.</i>
